**Bank, restaurant in the works**

Old National, O'Charley's will occupy spots in Riverwood Market Plaza along Ind. 135.

Residents soon will have the opportunity to satisfy their banking needs and fill their bellies in the same shopping center.

Old National bank is about to break ground at Riverwood Market Plaza, a center being developed by Allen Commercial Group. Also in the development -- located along Ind. 135 in front of Home Depot -- will be an O'Charley's restaurant, set to break ground this spring.

Dan Doan, Old National district president, said Greenwood's expanding population attracted the bank.

"Greenwood is one of the fastest-growing areas of greater Indianapolis," Doan said. "It was certainly a priority target for us to open a full-service financial service center there."

The building should be completed by late summer, Doan said.

Financial planning, insurance, commercial lending and investment services will be offered at the bank.

Old National, headquartered in Evansville, is the largest Indiana-based financial services holding company, with \$9.3 billion in assets and more than 3,000 employees.

Founded in 1834, Old National has locations throughout Indiana, Illinois, Kentucky, Ohio and Tennessee. The bank's central Indiana debut came in 2000 with a center on West Ohio Street in Indianapolis.

Old National branches also are under construction in Carmel and Fishers.

Three out lots will be built at the 130,000-square-foot Riverwood. Old National and O'Charley's will occupy two.
